





MPSS - Verifying Desired Capacity

Key Terms:

- Licensed Capacity is the total number of children the program is licensed or legally allowed to serve at one time.
- Desired Capacity is the total number of children the program chooses to serve at one time.

Overview

The More Details table in FCCO collects a program's **licensed and desired capacity** for each age group. For the Market Price and Supply Study, it is important to understand how to report desired capacity.

Many programs choose to **serve fewer** children at any time than allowed by licensing because of *physical space, staffing, and family needs.* However, the **Desired Capacity must never exceed** the **licensed capacity**. The amount of children a program chooses to serve at any given time must be reported under Desired Capacity.



Example Scenarios

- A center is licensed for 40 preschool-age children, but program decides to serve only up to 20 preschool-age children at any time. The center's licensed capacity for preschoolers is 40, and the desired capacity is 20.
- A part-day program serves 10 toddlers in the morning and 10 different toddlers in the afternoon. The desired capacity would be 10 children because is number of children served at one point in time.

Desired Capacity that changes over time.

- Programs that have different desired capacities at different times of day: Report desired capacity at the time when the largest number of children could be in attendance.
- i.e., "think about the point of your day that you would have the most children in the program. How many children do you have at that point in time?"
- Programs that have different desired capacities at different times of year: Report the current desired capacity as of this month.
- Programs that have different desired capacities depending on the age mix of the children attending the program: Report the ideal number by each age group they would prefer to serve
- i.e., if you were to have a golden ratio, how many children would you serve by age group?. If unsure, report the **number currently** served by age group as of today.
